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Accessing the Power of Belief in Your Words

Everything that exists is composed of sound energy. Albert Einstein's Theory of Relativity bares that truth out: $E=MC^2$ (Energy = Mass X Concentration of Light Squared). As a result of this truth, we recognize the power of the tongue. We can change the atmosphere by the words we speak. So why are the words we speak seemingly so powerless? A parent may speak to child commanding their child to go to bed "Jonny, it's time to go to bed", yet Jonny doesn't move. "I am going to count to three", One, two, three, suddenly Jonny hops up and high tails it to bed. Why did Jonny not move on the first command and yet actively complied to his parent's directive on the count of three? The reason rests in Jonny's belief system. He learned he did not have to comply on the first command, nor on the count of one or two, but when the number got to three, he learned he had to move because he had learned that by the count of three an action step was going to happen that would cause him pain and he did not want that to happen. Two things I would like to point out here: a relationship exists between the parent and child and a belief system exists in that relationship. Depending on the foundation of that relationship a connection is formed which is based on either love or fear. Jonny is either thinking my Mom or Dad loves me and wants me to go to bed for my benefit. Alternatively, my parents want to deprive me of the experience I am enjoying in the moment and want to take away an enjoyable experience I am having. It depends upon Jonny's perspective. It has been said children are very good observers of reality, but rather poor interpreters of reality.

This brings me to the premise of this ebook. Our words are powerless because we have been trained not to believe in the words we speak. Time and again we have lied to ourselves. Let me give an example: have you ever felt a pain in your body like a tooth ache and said: "This is killing me!" Of course, the toothache, while painful was not truly killing you, but you spoke words that you, yourself did not believe. Over and over again, we speak words and sayings that we do not believe and have trained

ourselves by our very experience that we do not believe in the words we speak. Therefore, when it comes time to pray or speak words which we want to have power in them, they end up having no power, because we don't believe our own words. After all, when a person says: "this is killing me" and they do not die, then does it really matter what words they say? If we really believed that something was killing me and chose to spoke it out loud then it would kill me. At least then you would have realized the power of your words, but you would no longer be in your body on the earth. Too late, you already are in heaven, hopefully! The thoughts and ideas contained herein will help you understand how to access power in your words on this side of the veil.

When Pilate was questioning Jesus, He did not open His mouth? Why not? Because if He had spoken at that moment, whatever He would have said would have happened, and He knew it. Jesus knew His words had power, immense power, so He did not open His mouth. His Father did not want Him to, because it would have ruined their plan.

Let me tell you a story about how beliefs are formed by words. First let me establish something: it is a well-known fact that words create pictures in our minds. Steve Jobs, the founder of Apple, realized this so he created icons to symbolize things. For example, a "trash can" symbolized the "delete" button. In the same way, when a person uses words to says something to us, we develop a picture in our minds and when we receive that picture, we develop a belief about that picture.

Many years ago, Greg Norman was the number one golfer in the world. To help promote golf in the middle east, the King of Saudi Arabia invited Greg to play in a charity tournament with many of the best golfers in the world. Greg reluctantly accepted the King's invitation, though naturally, the purse was very appealing as well. Understandably, Greg won the tournament and the King with all his friends and family and dignitaries were very pleased. Besides winning the tournament hands down, Greg Norman made the King look very good in front of his friends and invited guests from many countries. So, after the tournament when the trophies were given out, the King said to Greg Norman that he wanted to give him a gift of "golf clubs." Greg was happy that he won the purse of more than \$1,000,000 and this extra gift was a nice gesture, but he didn't really need

an extra set of golf clubs. However, Greg graciously accepted and said he was honored. Thereupon, the King said his assistant would be in touch. Greg returned to his home and several weeks passed with no golf clubs forthcoming from the King of Saudi Arabia, so he thought the King forgot. Nonetheless, after three weeks passed, a large Fedex package arrived at his home addressed to him. Greg opened the package and read the cover letter in bone white thick bond paper. The top of the stationery was embossed with gold leaf the letters HRH (His Royal Highness). The letter read in part, "Dear Mr. Norman" It pleases the King to offer you from his selection shown in the enclosed brochure any one of his "golf clubs". Greg opened the brochure and saw the most magnificent collection of full scale 18 hole golf clubs complete with beautifully manicured clubhouses. Greg thought the King was going to send him a set of "titanium sticks" when he said the words "golf clubs". From the Kings perspective "golf clubs" meant entire golf courses.

Does not the scripture tell us that "eye has not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him." What do you think is our Father's perspective of these words in Scripture as compared to our perspective? If a natural King can give good gifts as the King of Saudi Arabia did to Greg Norman, how much more so the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords will give us? For it is the Father's good pleasure to give us The Kingdom!

Greg Norman's belief system conditioned him to believe that the words "golf clubs" meant sticks. Is our belief system based on a natural perspective or a supernatural perspective? There is only one way we can develop a supernatural perspective, that is the Word of God.

If we believe the natural words we say, we may find power in them even though they are just natural. In the book "The Latent Power of the Soul", Watchman Nee describes the power of our soul. Our souls still retain power, even after the Fall. Satan continues to try to co-opt the power we still retain after the Fall. Mankind still possesses power to affect the earth through our belief system and the words we speak. Satan tries to convince us to believe the lies he tells us, and then after we believe his lies, use the power of our words to implement the actions we create by the power of our tongues on the earth. One need not look any further

than the destruction that is created on the earth through those who believe Satan's lies.

Words do have power in them for good or bad. Words release energy into the earth if we believe them! However, just believing something is not enough. What if what we believe is a lie? Do we want to implement the dominion of darkness? Of course not! Do we want to be impotent, with our words having no power? Of course not! So where does that leave us? At the feet of Him who loves us! Our Father who art in heaven, instructing us from His Word.

To put power in your words it's not good enough to just believe. Does not the scripture say "You believe there is one God, you do well. Even the demons believe and tremble". I take from this that belief is not enough, even demons believe. We need a relationship with our Father, a connection that the demons don't have, not just a belief system, even if the belief system is true.

There is a scripture that comes to mind, Hebrews 2:14-15 ⁴Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, ¹⁵ and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Satan tries every day and, in every way, possible to break the connection we have with our Father. Fear is his primary weapon. Fear of death is the "mother of all fears". If our connection with our Father becomes solid, so solid that nothing can disturb it, then Satan cannot have any effect on us. If we know who our Father is and through Him understand who we are, we shall not fear.

Then we will be able to actualize the power of our words. Mark 11: 22-24 ²² So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. ²³ For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. ²⁴ Therefore I say to you, whatever things you

ask when you pray, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*.

The Father's Heart Media has one mission: Malachi 4:6 "Bringing the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the hearts of the children to the fathers" This directive has become a one-track mindset: bring everyone into connection with the Father. 
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
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
